**HRSG ULTRASOUND STUDY OF NECK**  
**Study performed with 10.0MHz high frequency linear probe.**

- **Right lobe of thyroid** is normal in size and echotexture. Right lobe measures approx. 42 x 21 x 17 mm with volume 8.3cc. **A small tiny cystic nodule formation of size approx 5.3 x 3.4mm is seen in right lobe of thyroid - ? colloid nodule / ? nature.**
- **Left lobe of thyroid** is normal in size and echotexture. Left lobe measures approx. 42 x 25 x 18 mm with volume 10cc. No space occupying lesion is seen. Isthmus is seen normally.
- **Both carotid** arteries visualized are seen normally. No evidence of any plaque.
- Both internal jugular veins are seen normally.
- Bilateral submandibular glands are seen normally.
- **Few subcentimeteric right cervical lymphnodes are seen measuring upto approx 4.5 x 2.9mm (at level IIA, IIB) with maintained hilum.**

**IMPRESSION:**

- **A SMALL TINY CYSTIC NODULE FORMATION IN RIGHT LOBE OF THYROID - ? COLLOID NODULE / ? NATURE.**
- **FEW SUBCENTIMETERIC RIGHT CERVICAL LYMPHNODES WITH MAINTAINED HILUM.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
