INTRAVENOUS PYELOGRAPHY
CONTROL

- Multiple radio opaque shadows are seen in left lumbar region.

IVP

- Both kidneys are normal in size, shape, position, axis and outline and show prompt and simultaneous excretion of contrast.
- Right pelvi calyceal system is seen normally. Cupping is well maintained. Left ureter is normal in course and caliber.
- Left pelvi calyceal system is dilated. Right ureter is normal in course and caliber.
- Urinary bladder is normal in contour. No calculus or mass lesion is seen.
- Post void residue is insignificant.

IMPRESSION:

- **A LARGE LEFT P.U.J CALCULUS WITH HYDRONEPHROSIS.**
- **SMALL LEFT RENAL CALCULI.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
