INTRAVENOUS PYELOGRAPHY
CONTROL

- Two radio opaque shadows are seen in left renal region.
- Another radio opaque shadow is seen below transverse process of L2 vertebra on left side.

IVP

- Both kidneys are normal in size, shape, position, axis and outline and show prompt and simultaneous excretion of contrast.
- Right pelvi calyceal system is seen normally. Cupping is well maintained. Right ureter is normal in course and caliber.
- Left pelvi calyceal system is moderately dilated. Cupping is well maintained. Left ureter is normal in course and caliber.
- Urinary bladder is normal in contour. No calculus or mass lesion is seen.
- Post void residue is insignificant.

IMPRESSION:

- **LEFT P.U.J CALCULUS WITH MODERATE HYDRONEPHROSIS.**
- **LEFT RENAL CALCULI.**
