CT THORAX

HRCT STUDY OF THORAX

- **Bilateral mild apical pleural thickening is seen with few fibro-atelectatic bands in bilateral lungs. Tiny calcified nodule is seen in right upper lobe.** Rest of the lung fields are clear and show normal pulmonary architecture. No evidence of any other parenchymal opacity is seen.
- *Few subcentimeteric to centimeteric mediastinal lymph nodes are seen with the largest measuring approx. 12mm SAD seen at station 7.*
- Trachea is central.
- Heart size is normal.
- Esophagus is seen normally.
- *Degenerative changes are seen in visualized part of spine.*

OPINION:

- **NO OBVIOUS SIGNIFICANT ABNORMALITY DETECTED.**
