NCCT STUDY OF NOSE AND PARANASAL SINUSES

- Bilateral maxillary sinuses show minimal mucosal thickening. Right maxillary sinus shows septum. No evidence of any bony destruction is seen.
- Bilateral osteomeatal complexes are clear. No evidence of any blockage is seen.
- Bilateral frontal, ethmoid & left sphenoid sinuses show mucosal thickening. Septae are seen in frontal sinuses. Right sphenoid sinus is clear
- Nasal septum is deviated towards right side with septal spur.
- Bilateral inferior nasal turbinate hypertrophy are seen.
- No mass lesion is seen in nasopharynx or nasal cavity.

IMPRESSION:

- **MULTI SINUSITIS.**
- **DEVIATED NASAL SEPTUM WITH SEPTAL SPUR.**
- **BILATERAL INFERIOR NASAL TURBINATE HYPERTROPHY.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
