SKIAGRAM CHEST PA VIEW

- Both lung fields are clear.
- Bilateral hilar shadows are normal.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and body cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

OPINION

- NO ACTIVE LUNG PARENCHYMAL LESION IS DISCERNIBLE.

SKIAGRAM LUMBAR SPINE AP AND LATERAL VIEW

- Bone density is reduced.
- Antero-lateral osteophytes are seen arising from L1-5 levels.
- Paraspinal ligamentous calcification is seen in lumbar and lower dorsal vertebrae.
- Intervertebral disc spaces are maintained.
- Both SI joints show sclerosis.
