IMAGING SEQUENCES (NCMR)
AXIAL: T1 & T2 CORONAL: T2 & SAGITTAL: T1.

Trachea is central. Bifurcation is normally seen with normal bronchial segmental divisions. No obvious intraluminal pathology noted. Mediastinal great vessels are normally identified with normal cardiac configuration. No significant mediastinal lymphadenopathy is seen.

Both lungs are normal in aeration & volume and MR morphology with bronchovascular divisions normal. No obvious focal parenchymal lesions are seen. No interstitial pathology is noted. No pleural effusion or thickening is seen.

No any obvious abnormality is seen in chest wall.
