ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

Highly compromised scan due to gaseous abdomen.

- **Liver** is normal in size and **shows increased echotexture of liver parenchyma**. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. **Minimal hydronephrosis is seen on both side – most likely due to back pressure changes**. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 88 x 45 mm in size. Left kidney measures 95 x 46 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is normal in contour with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- **Uterus** is normal in size, measures 69 x 22 mm and shows homogenous myometrial echotexture. Endometrial thickness measures 7.8 mm. No endometrial collection is seen. No mass lesion is seen.
- **Cervix** is normal.
- **Both ovaries** are normal in size and **show multiple tiny peripherally arranged follicles**.
- No adnexal mass lesion is seen.
- No free fluid is seen in Cul-de-Sac.

OPINION:

- **FATTY INFILTRATION OF LIVER GRADE I.**
- **MULTIPLE TINY PERIPHERALLY ARRANGED FOLLICLES IN BOTH OVARIES (ADV : HORMONAL ASSAY).**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
