HRCT STUDY OF THORAX

Compromised assessment due to motion artifacts

- **Few fibro-atelectatic bands are seen in bilateral lungs.** Rest of the lung fields are clear and show normal pulmonary architecture. No evidence of any other parenchymal opacity is seen.
- No pleural effusion is seen on either side.
- *Few subcentimetric mediastinal lymphnodes are seen.*
- Trachea is central.
- Heart size is normal.
- Esophagus is seen normally.
- *Appended sections of abdomen show large heterogeneous lesion in right side of abdomen.*

- **NO OBVIOUS EVIDENCE OF PULMONARY METASTASIS ON PRESENT STUDY.**
