**SKIAGRAM CHEST PA VIEW**

- Broncho-vascular markings are prominent.
- Bilateral hilar shadows are mildly prominent.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

**CT STUDY OF HEAD**

**Infratentorial**

- Cerebellopontine angle and prepontine cisterns are seen normally.
- Fourth ventricle is normal in size and midline in location.
- Cerebellar parenchyma and brain stem appears to be normal.

**Supratentorial**

- Bilateral cerebral parenchyma shows normal gray and white matter differentiation.
- No subdural or extradural collection is seen.
- Third and both lateral ventricles are normal in size.
- Basal cisterns are clear.
- No midline shift is seen.

**Bony architecture**

- No obvious fracture is seen.

**IMPRESSION:**

- NO POST TRAUMATIC INTRACRANIAL PATHOLOGY IS SEEN.
