ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

- **Liver** is mildly enlarged in size (~ 166 mm) and shows increased echotexture of liver parenchyma. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is moderately to grossly enlarged in size (~ 174 mm) and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 101 x 45 mm in size. Left kidney measures 117 x 46 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is normal in contour with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- Bilateral seminal vesicles are seen normally.
- **Prostate** is borderline enlarged in size, measures 34 x 36 x 33 mm with weight of 21gms and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No mass lesion is seen.
- Post void residual urine volume – Nil.

OPINION:

- **Mild hepatomegaly with fatty infiltration of liver grade-I.**
- **Moderate to gross splenomegaly.**
- **Borderline prostatomegaly.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.

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SKIAGRAM CHEST PA VIEW

- Both lung fields are clear.
- Bilateral hilar shadows are normal.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits. Unfolding of aorta is seen .
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

IMPRESSION:

- NO ACTIVE LUNG PARENCHYMAL LESION IS DISCERNIBLE.
