ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

- **Liver** is moderately enlarged in size measures 180 mm and shows mild coarse echotexture of liver parenchyma. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. **GB wall is diffusely edematous.**
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is moderately enlarged in size measures 166 mm and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- **Moderate to gross ascites is seen.**
- **Both kidneys** are **borderline bulky & swollen** and normal in position. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 117 x 55 mm in size. Left kidney measures 120 x 52 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is normal in contour with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- Bilateral seminal vesicles are seen normally.
- **Prostate** is normal in size, measures 45 x 28 x 30 mm with weight of 20gms and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No mass lesion is seen.

OPINION:

- **Moderate hepato-splenomegaly with mild coarse echotexture of liver parenchyma with diffusely edematous GB wall & moderate to gross ascites – s/o ? Chronic liver disease (ADV : LFT & Fibroscan).**
- **Bilateral bulky & swollen kidneys - ? Infective etiology.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
