CT STUDY OF HEAD PLAIN AND CONTRAST

Posterior Fossa

- Cerebellopontine angle and prepontine cisterns are seen normally.
- Fourth ventricle is normal in size and midline in location.
- Rest of cerebellar parenchyma and brain stem appears to be normal.
- Cerebellar tonsil is reaching just caudal to McRae's line.....? Benign tonsillar ectopia...?? significance.

Supratentorial

- Calcified nodule without surrounding edema is seen in right frontal lobe? Calcified granuloma.
- Basal cisterns are seen normally.
- Third and both lateral ventricles are seen normally.
- No midline shift is seen.

IMPRESSION:

- TINY CALCIFIED NODULE WITHOUT SURROUNDING EDEMA IN RIGHT FRONTAL LOBE? CALCIFIED GRANULOMA
- CEREBELLAR TONSIL IS REACHING JUST CAUDAL TO MCRAE'S LINE.....? BENIGN TONSILLAR ECTOPIA...?? SIGNIFINANCE.

Clinical correlation is necessary.
