ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

- **Liver** is mildly enlarged in size, and shows homogenously increased echotexture of liver parenchyma. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is mildly enlarged in size [124mm] and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 91 x 37 mm in size. Left kidney measures 97 x 41 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is partially distended with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- **Uterus** is normal in size, measures 79 x 41 x 57 mm and shows homogenous myometrial echotexture. Endometrial thickness measures 7.6 mm. No endometrial collection is seen. No mass lesion is seen.
- **Cervix** is normal.
- **Both ovaries** are normal in size and echotexture.
- No adnexal mass lesion is seen.
- No free fluid is seen in Cul-de-Sac.

OPINION:

- **MILD HEPATO-SPLENOMEGALY WITH FATTY INFILTRATION OF LIVER GRADE-I.**

(Possibility of acid peptic disease could not be ruled out).
