CT THORAX

HRCT STUDY OF THORAX

- Left lower lobe shows cystic and tubular bronchial dilatation with reduced volume of left hemithorax. Few fibrotic bands are seen in both apices. Rest of lungs fields are clear and show normal pulmonary architecture. No evidence of any other parenchymal opacity, area of consolidation or any mass lesion is seen.
- No pleural effusion or pleural thickening is seen on either side.
- No mediastinal lymphadenopathy is seen.
- Trachea is central.
- Heart size is enlarged.
- Esophagus is seen normally.
- Soft tissues are seen normally.

OPINION:

- **LEFT LOWER LOBE CYSTIC BRONCHIECTASIS WITH REDUCED LUNG VOLUME FEW FIBROTIC BANDS IN BOTH APICES ---- MOST LIKELY SEQUELAE OF OLD INFECTIVE PATHOLOGY [?? OLD KOCH'S].**
- **CARDIOMEGALY.**
