CT THORAX

HRCT STUDY OF CHEST

- Cystic, tubular & varicose bronchial (mainly proximal bronchial) dilatation is seen in both lungs. Bronchial wall thickening is seen with peribronchial opacities (more in right upper lobe). No area of consolidation / space occupying lesion is seen.
- No pleural effusion or pleural thickening is seen on either side.
- Few enlarged & subcentimetric mediastinal nodes are seen, largest measuring 13 x 11 mm.
- Trachea is central.
- Heart size is normal.
- Esophagus is seen normally.
- Soft tissues are seen normally.

OPINION:

- **MARKED BILATERAL PROXIMAL BRONCHIECTASIS AS DESCRIBED WITH BRONCHIAL WALL THICKENING WITH PERIBRONCHIAL OPACITIES (MORE IN RIGHT UPPER LOBE) WITH ENLARGED MEDIASTINAL NODES - MOST LIKELY SEQUELAE OF ALLERGIC BRONCHOPULMONARY ASPERGILLOSIS.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
