ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

Excessive gaseous abdomen

- **Liver** is mildly enlarged in size (~170mm) and shows increased echotexture of liver parenchyma. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. A simple cortical cyst (Bosniak type-I) is seen at mid pole of right kidney measuring approx 9.3 x 9.1mm. Few (2 in no.) adjacent calculi are seen at mid & lower poles of left kidney measuring approx 18.1mm, 10.9mm. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 87 x 40 mm in size. Left kidney measures 88 x 42 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is partially distended with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- Bilateral seminal vesicles are seen normally.
- **Prostate** is enlarged in size, measures 37 x 35 x 35 mm with weight of 25gms and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No mass lesion is seen.

OPINION:

- MILD HEPATOMEGALY WITH FATTY INFILTRATION OF LIVER GRADE-I.
- SIMPLE RIGHT RENAL CORTICAL CYST.
- LEFT RENAL CALCULI.
- PROSTATOMEGALY GRADE-I.

(Possibility of acid peptic disease could not be ruled out).

Clinical correlation is necessary.

- Patchy parenchymal opacities are seen in right lower zone paracardiac region ...? Infective.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

Adv: Repeat X-ray after a course of antibiotics.
