**CECT STUDY OF FACE & NECK**

- **Asymmetric mildly enhancing soft tissue thickening measuring approx. 17 x 5 x 16 mm is seen involving left buccal mucosa complex. It is just reaching upto inferior gingivo buccal sulcus. Posteriorly it is just reaching upto retromolar trigone and showing maintained interface with masticator muscle.**
- *Few subcentimeteric bilateral cervical lymphnodes are seen with the largest measuring approx. 7 mm in MSAD seen at left level Ib.*
- *Bilateral tonsillar fossae appear slightly bulky. Rest of the nasopharynx and oropharynx are seen normally.*
- *Bilateral submandibular and parotid glands are seen normally.*
- *The aryepiglottic folds and epiglottis are seen normally.*
- *The valleculae and pyriform sinuses are seen normally.*
- *The laryngeal airway and cartilages are seen normally.*
- *Thyroid gland is normal in size and density.*
