CECT STUDY OF FACE & NECK

- Asymmetric mildly enhancing soft tissue thickening measuring approx. 17 x 5 x 16 mm is seen involving left buccal mucosa complex. It is just reaching upto inferior gingivo buccal sulcus. Posteriorly it is just reaching upto retromolar trigone and showing maintained interface with masticator muscle.
- Few subcentimeteric bilateral cervical lymphnodes are seen with the largest measuring approx. 7 mm in MSAD seen at left level Ib.
- Bilateral tonsillar fossae appear slightly bulky. Rest of the nasopharynx and oropharynx are seen normally.
- Bilateral submandibular and parotid glands are seen normally.
- The aryepiglottic folds and epiglottis are seen normally.
- The valleculae and pyriform sinuses are seen normally.
- The laryngeal airway and cartilages are seen normally.
- Thyroid gland is normal in size and density.
