ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

Excessive gaseous abdomen

- **Liver** is mildly enlarged in size (~124mm) and shows homogenous echotexture of liver parenchyma. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- **Few subcentimetric mesenteric lymphnodes are seen measuring upto approx 11 x 8.4mm (non specific).**
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 69 x 29 mm in size. Left kidney measures 64 x 29 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is normal in contour with **few floating internal echoes in lumen.** No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- Prostate is normal for child age group.

OPINION:

- **MILD HEPATOMEGALY.**
- **FEW SUBCENTIMETERIC MESENTERIC LYMPHNODES (NON SPECIFIC).**
- **FEW FLOATING INTERNAL ECHOES IN UB LUMEN - ? CYSTITIS (ADV: URINE R/M).**

Clinical correlation is necessary.

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SKIAGRAM CHEST PA VIEW

- Ill defined opacity is seen in right para-hilar region --? infective.
- Bilateral hilar shadows are prominent.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

Adv: Repeat X-ray after a course of antibiotics.
