SKIAGRAM CERVICAL SPINE AP AND LATERAL VIEW

- Small anterior & posterior osteophytes are seen arising from C4-C6 cervical vertebrae.
- Intervertebral disc spaces are maintained.
- Posterior elements are seen normally.
- No cervical rib is seen.
- No CVJ anomaly is seen.

IMPRESSION:

- **EARLY CERVICAL SPONDYLOSIS.**

SKIAGRAM LUMBAR SPINE AP AND LATERAL VIEW

- Transitional vertebra is seen at L5-s1 level with pseudoarthrosis on right side .
- Small antero-lateral osteophytes are seen arising from L1-L5 lumbar vertebrae.
- Intervertebral disc spaces are maintained.
- Posterior elements are seen normally.
- Both SI joints are normal.

Clinical correlation is necessary.
