ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

- **Liver** is normal in size, and shows homogenous echotexture of liver parenchyma. No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 78 x 32 mm in size. Left kidney measures 96 x 42 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is normal in contour with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- **Uterus** is normal in size, measures 57 x 32 mm and **shows a well defined rounded hypoechoic lesion of size 31 x 31 x 33 mm in right adnexa abutting the uterine wall.** Endometrial thickness measures 5.5 mm. No endometrial collection is seen.
- **Cervix** is normal.
- **Both ovaries** are normal in size and echotexture.
- No free fluid is seen in Cul-de-Sac.

OPINION:

- **A WELL DEFINED ROUNDED HYPOECHOIC LESION IN RIGHT ADNEXA ABUTTING THE UTERINE WALL - S/O ? SUBSEROUSAL FIBROID.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
