### **ULTRASOUND STUDY OF OBSTETRICS**

- Single irregular gestational sac is seen in uterine cavity.
- Gestation sac measures 9.4 mm corresponding to POG of 5 weeks + 5 days.
- **Yolk sac & fetal cardiac activity is not visualized.**
- **Decidual reaction is poor.** No perigestational collection is seen.
- Cervical OS is closed.
- Cervical length and width is normal measures 3.4cms.
- Both ovaries are normal in size and echotexture.
- No adnexal mass lesion is seen.

#### **OPINION:**

- **EARLY INTRAUTERINE PREGNANCY OF 5 WEEKS + 5 DAYS (BY GESTATIONAL SAC DIMENSION) WITH NON-VISUALIZATION OF YOLK SAC, FETAL CARDIAC ACTIVITY & POOR DECIDUAL REACTION.**

**ADV : FOLLOW UP AFTER 1-2 WEEKS FOR FETAL VIABILITY.**
