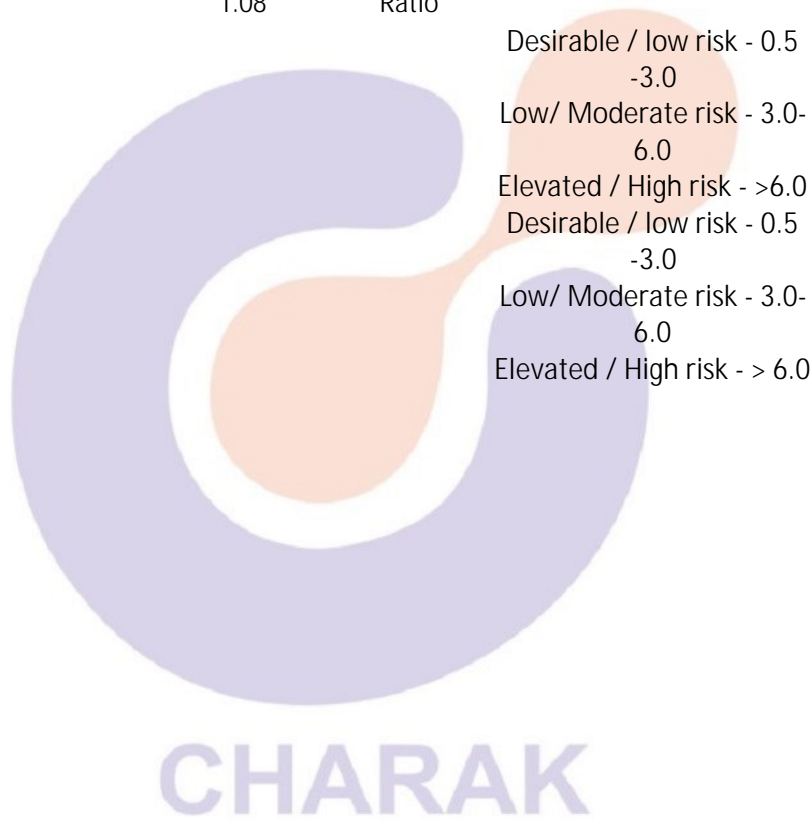

SKIAGRAM CHEST PA VIEW

- Small healed calcified foci are seen in right lower zone.
- Rest of the both lung field is clear.
- Bilateral hilar shadows are normal.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

IMPRESSION:

- **NO ACTIVE LUNG PARENCHYMAL LESION IS DISCERNIBLE EXCEPT FOR HEALED CALCIFIED FOCI.**
