**NCCT STUDY OF RIGHT KNEE JOINT**

- Fracture proximal tibia is seen in midline along posterior aspect in intercondylar region with large separated bony fragment .
- Mild fluid collection is seen in knee joint space.
- No evidence of any lytic or sclerotic area is seen. No bony destruction is seen.
- Right knee joint is seen normally. Joint spaces are maintained. Articular surfaces are smoothly outlined.
- Right distal femur is seen normally.
- Right patella is normal .
- Proximal patella is normal .

**IMPRESSION:**

- **FRACTURE PROXIMAL TIBIA IN MIDLINE ALONG POSTERIOR ASPECT WITH LARGE SEPARATED BONY FRAGMENT WITH KNEE JOINT HEMARTHROSIS ...MOST LIKELY P.C.L AVULSION INJURY .**
