**SKIAGRAM CERVICAL SPINE AP AND LATERAL VIEW**

- Anterior & posterior osteophytes are seen arising from C4-C6 cervical vertebrae.
- Intervertebral disc spaces are maintained.
- Posterior elements are seen normally.
- No cervical rib is seen.
- No CVJ anomaly is seen.
- Calcified lymphnode is seen in upper lumbar region.

**IMPRESSION:**

- **CERVICAL SPONDYLOSIS.**

**SKIAGRAM LUMBAR SPINE AP AND LATERAL VIEW**

- Antero-lateral osteophytes are seen arising from L1-L5 lumbar vertebrae.
- Intervertebral disc spaces are maintained.
- Posterior elements are seen normally.
- Both SI joints are normal.
- Focal calcification of abdominal aorta is seen.

**OPINION**

- **LUMBAR SPONDYLOSIS.**

**SKIAGRAM CHEST PA VIEW**

- Fibrotic opacity is seen in right mid zone.
- Bilateral hilar shadows are prominent.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply outlined.
