CONTROL

- Multiple radio opaque shadows are seen in left renal region .

IVP

- Both kidneys are normal in size, shape, position, axis and outline and show prompt and simultaneous excretion of contrast.
- Right pelvi calyceal system is seen normally. Cupping is well maintained. Right ureter is normal in course and caliber.
- Left pelvi calyceal system is mildly dilated. Left ureter is prominent up to SI joint? Recently passed calculus .

- Urinary bladder is normal in contour. No calculus or mass lesion is seen.
- Post void residue is insignificant.

IMPRESSION:

MULTIPLE LEFT RENAL CALCULI WITH MILD HYDRO-URETERONEPHROSIS .
