NCCT STUDY OF NOSE AND PARANASAL SINUSES AXIAL AND CORONAL

- Both maxillary sinuses are opacified. No evidence of any bony destruction is seen.
- Bilateral osteomeatal complexes are blocked.
- Ethmoid, sphenoid and frontal sinuses show mucosal thickening .
- Nasal septum is minimally deviated to right .
- Bilateral inferior nasal turbinate hypertrophy is seen .
- No mass lesion is seen in nasopharynx or nasal cavity.

IMPRESSION:

**PAN SINUSITIS .
BILATERAL INFERIOR NASAL TURBINATE HYPERTROPHY .**
