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NCCT STUDY OF HEAD

Infratentorial

- Cerebellopontine angle and prepontine cisterns are seen normally.
- Fourth ventricle is normal in size and midline in location.
- Cerebellar parenchyma and brain stem appears to be normal.

Supratentorial

- Cortical sulci are prominent.
- Bilateral cerebral parenchyma shows normal gray and white matter differentiation.
- No subdural or extradural collection is seen.
- Third and both lateral ventricles are dilated.
- Basal cisterns are clear.
- No midline shift is seen.

Bony architecture

- No obvious fracture is seen.
- Soft tissue scalp swelling is seen in right frontal region.
- Multiple sinuses show mucosal thickening.

IMPRESSION:

- NO POST TRAUMATIC INTRACRANIAL PATHOLOGY IS SEEN.
- SOFT TISSUE SCALP SWELLING IN RIGHT FRONTAL REGION.
- DIFFUSE CEREBRAL ATROPHY.
- MULTI-SINUSITIS.

Clinical correlation is necessary.
