ULTRASOUND STUDY OF OBSTETRICS

- Single gestational sac is seen in uterine cavity.
- Gestation sac measures 21.6 mm corresponding to POG of 7 weeks + 1 day.
- **Yolk sac & fetal cardiac activity is not visualized.**
- Decidual reaction is normal. **Minimal perigestational collection is noted (measuring approx. 13 x 6.2 x 15.7 mm vol. 0.6 cc).**
- Cervical OS is closed.
- Cervical length and width is normal measures 2.8cms.
- Both ovaries are normal in size and echotexture.
- No adnexal mass lesion is seen.

OPINION:

- **EARLY INTRAUTERINE PREGNANCY OF 7 WEEKS + 1 DAY (BY GESTATIONAL SAC DIMENSION) WITH NON-VISUALIZATION OF YOLK SAC, FETAL CARDIAC ACTIVITY & MINIMAL PERIGESTATIONAL COLLECTION – ? NON VIABLE PREGNANCY.**

ADV: FOLLOW UP & β-HCG CORRELATION.
