CT STUDY OF HEAD

Infratentorial

- Cerebellopontine angle and prepontine cisterns are seen normally.
- Fourth ventricle is normal in size and midline in location.
- Cerebellar parenchyma and brain stem appears to be normal.

Supratentorial

- Cortical sulci are prominent.
- Faintly hyperdense area is seen in left temporal lobe with surrounding hypodensity .
- Third and both lateral ventricles are prominent. Paraventricular white matter hypodensities are seen.
- Bilateral basal ganglia calcifications are seen .
- Basal cisterns are clear.
- No midline shift is seen.

IMPRESSION:

- **RESOLVING LEFT TEMPORAL BLEED WITH SURROUNDING EDEMA .**
- **DIFFUSE CEREBRAL ATROPHY WITH WHITE MATTER ISCHEMIC CHANGES.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
