CT STUDY OF HEAD

Infratentorial

- Cerebellopontine angle and prepontine cisterns are seen normally.
- Fourth ventricle is normal in size and midline in location.
- Cerebellar parenchyma and brain stem appears to be normal.

Supratentorial

- Cortical sulci are prominent.
- Bilateral cerebral parenchyma shows normal gray and white matter differentiation.
- Third and both lateral ventricles are normal in size.
- Basal cisterns are clear.
- No midline shift is seen.
- Evidence of surgical metallic fixation is seen on left side in periorbital region.

IMPRESSION:

- **PROMINENT CORTICAL SULCI .**
- **NO EVIDENCE SUGGESTIVE OF ANY OTHER FOCAL PARENCHYMAL DISEASE OR ANY SPACE OCCUPYING LESION IS IDENTIFIED.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
