INTERPRETATION:

Ammonia is elevated in the following condition: Liver disease, Urinary tract infection with retention and stasis, reye syndrome, inborn errors of metabolism including deficiency of enzymes in the urea cycle, HHH syndrome (hyperammonemia-homocitrullinuria, hyperornithinemia), some normal neonates (usually returning to normal in 48 hours), total parenteral nutrition, ureterosigmoidostomy, and sodium valproate therapy. Ammonia determination is neonates with neurological deterioration, subject with lethargy and/or emesis not explained, and patients with possible encephalopathy. Ammonia measurements are mainly of use in the diagnosis of urea cycle deficiencies (any neonate with unexplained nausea, vomiting or neurological deterioration appearing after first feeding).

Test value may vary depending upon time interval between sample collection and testing
