**CT STUDY OF HEAD**

**Infratentorial**

- Cerebellopontine angle and prepontine cisterns are seen normally.
- Fourth ventricle is normal in size and midline in location.
- Cerebellar parenchyma and brain stem appears to be normal.

**Supratentorial**

- Cortical sulci and CSF spaces are prominent.
- Both the cerebral hemisphere show normal gray and white matter differentiation.
- Third and both lateral ventricles are prominent.
- Basal cisterns are clear.
- No midline shift is seen.

**IMPRESSION:**

- **MILD DIFFUSE CEREBRAL ATROPHY.**

**Note : acute infarcts may not be seen on ct for up to 48-72 hours.**

**Clinical correlation is necessary.**
