CT THORAX

HRCT STUDY OF THORAX

- Patchy & fibrotic parenchymal opacities are seen in right upper lobe & few in right middle lobe. Rest of lung fields are clear and show normal pulmonary architecture. No evidence of any other parenchymal opacity, area of consolidation or any mass lesion is seen.
- Focal pleural thickening is seen in right upper lobe. No pleural effusion is seen.
- No mediastinal lymphadenopathy is seen.
- Trachea is central.
- Heart size is normal.
- Esophagus is seen normally.
- Soft tissues are seen normally.

OPINION:

- **PATCHY & FIBROTIC PARENCHYMAL OPACITIES IN RIGHT UPPER LOBE & FEW IN RIGHT MIDDLE LOBE WITH FOCAL PLEURAL THICKENING IN RIGHT UPPER LOBE.
MOST LIKELY SEQUELAE OF INFECTIVE PATHOLOGY (?? KOCH'S CHEST).**
