## **CEMRI: PELVIS**

### **IMAGING SEQUENCES (CEMR)**

**AXIAL: T1 & T2 Wis. CORONAL: T2. SAGITTAL: T1 & T2**

**Post Contrast : T1 sagittal, axial & coronal**

**Clinical profile** : Follow up operated case of squamous cell carcinoma left gluteal region.

Post operative changes with diffuse soft tissue edema is seen in left gluteal region. Left gluteal muscle is atrophic & edematous. Small subcutaneous collection with thickening (measuring approx 16x 19x 30mm) is seen in left upper gluteal region with involvement of overlying skin.

Small well defined peripherally enhancing lesion (measuring approx 19x 15mm) is seen in left gluteal region deep to the gluteus maximus muscle, focally abutting obturator internus muscle.

Few enlarged peripherally enhancing necrotic lymph nodes are seen in left superficial inguinal region, largest measuring approx 28x 19mm. No encasement of femoral vessels is seen.

Few subcentimetric left external & common iliac lymph nodes are seen, largest measuring approx 21x 8mm in left external iliac region. No evidence of internal necrosis is seen.

Urinary bladder is well distended.

Prostate is normal in size, outline and signal intensity pattern.

Seminal vesicles are bilaterally normally visualized.

No free fluid is seen in peritoneal cavity.

Both the hip joints are showing normal articulation and alignment.



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**IMPRESSION:**

- **Post operative changes with diffuse soft tissue edema in left gluteal region**
- **Small well defined peripherally enhancing lesion in left gluteal region deep to the gluteus maximus muscle - ? deposit.**
- **Few enlarged necrotic left inguinal lymph nodes.**
