ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

- **Liver is mildly enlarged in size, and shows mild inhomogeneous echotexture of liver parenchyma.** No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is normal in size and shows anechoic lumen. No calculus / mass lesion is seen. GB walls are not thickened
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. **Right kidney shows a well defined cyst measuring approx. 9 x 9mm at upper pole.** No calculus is seen. **Bilateral raised renal parenchymal echogenicity with maintained cortico-medullary differentiation.** No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 94 x 43 mm in size. Left kidney measures 101 x 42 mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is normal in contour with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- **Uterus** is not visualized (post operative).
- No adnexal mass lesion is seen.

OPINION:

- **MILD HEPATOMEGALY WITH MILD INHOMOGENEOUS ECHOTEXTURE OF LIVER PARENCHYMA.**
- **RIGHT RENAL SIMPLE CORTICAL CYST.**
- **BILATERAL RAISED RENAL PARENCHYMAL ECHOGENICITY WITH MAINTAINED CORTICO-MEDULLARY DIFFERENTIATION---? AGE RELATED.**

Clinical correlation is necessary.
