ULTRASOUND STUDY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

Compromised assessment due to excessive bowel gases.

- **Liver is mildly enlarged in size and shows increased echotexture of liver parenchyma.** No intrahepatic biliary radicle dilatation is seen. No space occupying lesion is seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are seen normally.
- **Gall bladder** is severely contracted.
- **CBD** is normal at porta. No obstructive lesion is seen.
- **Portal vein** Portal vein is normal at porta.
- **Pancreas** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. PD is not dilated. No parenchymal calcification is seen. No peripancreatic collection is seen.
- **Spleen is mildly enlarged in size** and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No SOL is seen.
- No retroperitoneal adenopathy is seen.
- No ascites is seen.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in size and position. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. Parenchymal thickness is normal. No scarring is seen. Right kidney measures 98 x 48 mm in size. Left kidney measures 107 x 55mm in size.
- **Ureters** Both ureters are not dilated. UVJ are seen normally.
- **Urinary bladder** is partially distended with anechoic lumen. No calculus or mass lesion is seen. UB walls are not thickened.
- Bilateral seminal vesicles are seen normally.
- **Prostate** is normal in size and shows homogenous echotexture of parenchyma. No mass lesion is seen.

OPINION:

- **Mild hepato-splenomegaly with fatty infiltration of liver grade-I.**

(Possibility of acid peptic disease could not be ruled out).

Clinical correlation is necessary.

- Hazy opacity is seen in left lower zone? Infective.
- Cardiac shadow is within normal limits.
- Both CP angles are clear.
- Soft tissue and bony cage are seen normally.
- Both domes of diaphragm are sharply defined.

Adv: Repeat X-ray after a course of antibiotics.
